

Mura Plugin Throwdown

Overview

The throwdown will be hosted at <http://coldfusionthrowdown.com/> and run from January 4th, 2010 until January 29th, 2010. All entries submitted prior to midnight January 30th, 2010 will be eligible for judging. A winner will be selected based on the highest cumulative score awarded by three judges. The winner will be announced February 5th, 2010. Each week 1 or 2 entries will be selected and showcased on the CFThrowdown blog. Being featured does not indicate standings in the throwdown and is simply to showcase the functionality and flexibility of the Mura platform through example.

Judges

Judges will be required to setup an instance of Mura 5.1 either locally (express) or on a server (standard). Both codebases can be found at <http://www.getmura.com/index.cfm/download/>. Each plugin submitted during this throwdown should be installed in this Mura instance. Each judge is allowed to award up to but not exceeding 100 points based on the following criteria. Each plugin can be awarded a maximum of 300 points, the sum of the maximum points available to each judge.

Creativity / Originality: Maximum of 50 points.

Usefulness: Maximum of 25 points.

Ease of Use / Usability: Maximum of 25 points.

Requirements

All plugins submitted must adhere to the following standards.

- Open Source and freely available.
- Mura 5.1 compatible.
- Compatible with ColdFusion 7mx+, Railo 3.1+, or Open BlueDragon 1.2+.
- A URL pointing to either the plugin's project page or the plugin's zip file.
